Outdoor Burning Regulations & Burn Permits:

All outdoor burning requires a valid Burn Permit issued by Rio Arriba County.

Outdoor burning is restricted to yard waste; burning of trash is never permitted.

Outdoor burning is only allowed on weekend days (Saturday & Sunday) during daylight hours.

Outdoor burning is not allowed on national holidays and holiday weekends.

Outdoor burning is prohibited at all times if Rio Arriba County declares a burn ban.

Outdoor burns must be phoned in to (505) 753-5555 at least 20 minutes before burning.

Dixon VFD must respond to all 9-1-1 calls made by citizens who have concerns about a burn.

All outdoor burning should be carefully supervised with an adequate water source available.

Dixon VFD has the authority to extinguish any illegal burn or any burn that is not under control

How to obtain a burn permit:

You will send a completed application back to their office.

A Burn Permit is not valid until it has been approved by their office and returned to you.

Burn Permits are valid indefinitely and do not expire.
